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We performed a cross sectional descriptive study with adolescents Secondary

Level Educational Institution 0425 "Cesar Vallejo" Uchiza. San Martin, which was

conducted between 2012 and 2013, with the objective of determining the

sociocultural factors that influence the onset of intercourse among adolescents in

study. The information was obtained through a structured questionnaire developed

for this purpose, the same that was applied prior training and consent. We used the

non-probabilistic sampling.

The results found that of the 100 students (20 students per grade), 46 were male

and 54 were female. Also that 100% of students surveyed, 29% reported that they

start their sexual life, at an average age of 15 years corresponding to 41.4%, with

male students with the highest percentage is 65.5% and 34, 5% female. It was also

found that the reason for initiation of intercourse was by choice corresponding to

55.2% and 37.9% while it was out of curiosity as to the place where they had their

relationship was at the home of his partner in a 51.7% students also mentioned

that they had intercourse for the first time with his partner in a 55.2% and a friend

(a) by 41.2%. Students' feelings after first intercourse were scared by 55.2%.

In conclusion we can say that sociocultural factors such as age, sex, economics

and family structure, if they influence the onset of relationships among students,

demonstrated by the results mentioned above.
